Families for Bible Memory Association (FBMA) is a non-profit, faith-based ministry organized in 1993 in California. Before that we were the Southwest Chapter of the Bible Memory Association (BMA). Our purpose is to see the salvation and growth in Christ of men, women and children through the memory of the Holy Scriptures. We offer a variety of memory programs for all ages, from 3 to 103. The programs are time-tested and have been a blessing to many for many years. We pray for each other regularly by name. We meet periodically in various locations to encourage each other and to make decisions regarding this ministry. All interested parties are welcome to attend our meetings and, in fact, the only requirement of membership on our governing board is attendance and fidelity to our doctrinal statement.

We divide the year into three sessions: Winter, Summer, and Fall. Everyone chooses which session or sessions they will memorize in, which memory book they will use, how many verses per week they will memorize, and who their Hearer or Supervisor will be. The Hearer must be willing to listen to the recitations on a regular basis. We will periodically ask the Hearer to report on the quality of the recitations. At the end of the session, if the memorizer has faithfully completed the number of verses per week to which they committed, they will be issued a certificate of completion. When they satisfactorily complete their entire memory book they will be issued an on-line gift certificate to Christian Book Distributors ([www.ChristianBook.com](http://www.ChristianBook.com)). If funds and staffing permit we may also issue an invitation to attend a family camp in the summer.

We don't sell our memory books apart from our program.

We offer memory programs for the following age-groups:

- Preschool
- Elementary
- Secondary
- College
- Adult
